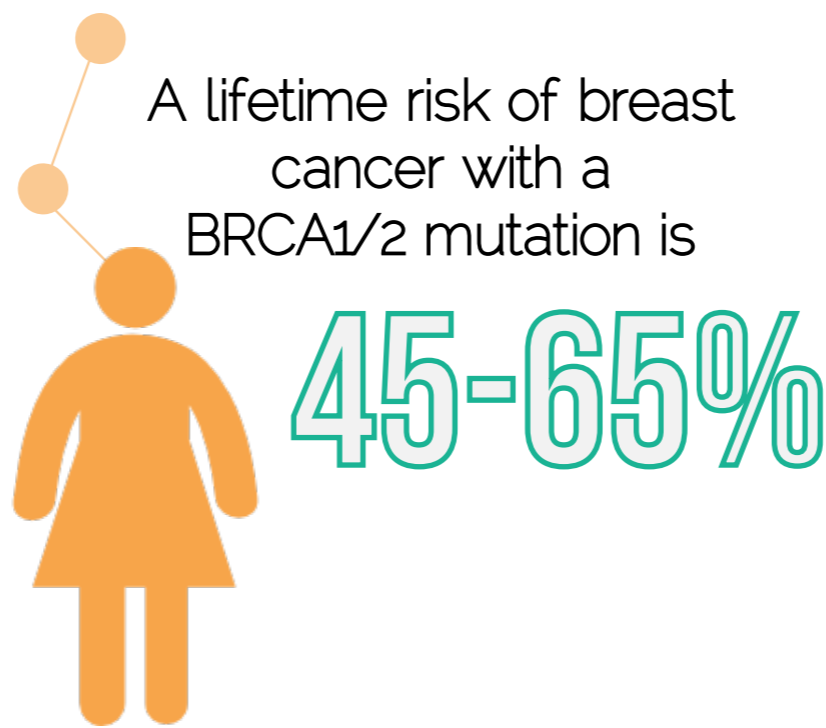
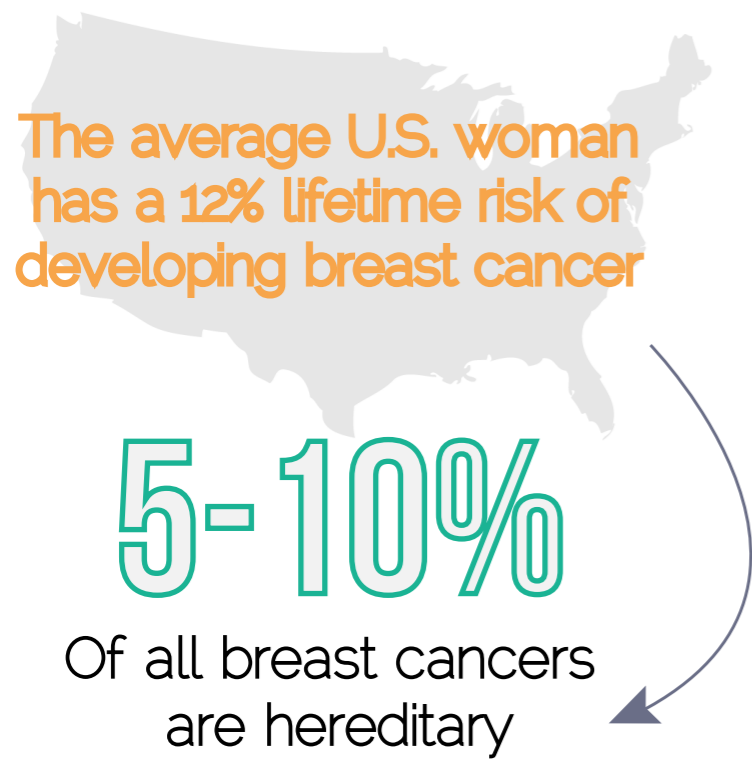


Are you at risk of Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer?

Here are some key facts to know...



Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer Syndrome (HBOC):

A family history of breast and ovarian cancer caused by changes in your genes.



Only 10% Actually know it

You should consider genetic counseling for HBOC if you or a family member have a history of :

- ❑ Both Breast and Ovarian Cancer
- ❑ Breast cancer diagnosed before age 50
- ❑ Two primary breast cancers
- ❑ Male breast cancer
- ❑ Triple negative breast cancer
- ❑ Ashkanazie-Jewish heritage with a history of breast and/or ovarian cancer
- ❑ A previously identified HBOC syndrome mutation in the family

What is a Genetic Counselor?

A specialist trained to evaluate how family history and genetics can impact a patient's cancer risk.

How does Genetic Counseling Work ?



Collect and Review Family History



Identify possible risks and hereditary patterns



Determine if testing is needed



Discuss risk-reducing strategies and screening options
